

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding the show, obedience trial, field trial, or hunt test has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show, obedience trial, field trial, or hunt test and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, trophies, or other prizes, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, show secretary or field trial secretary or hunting test secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience or field trial premises or grounds or near the entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial or field trial or hunt test, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

 Horseback handling allowed in both Championships. Horses will be kept at a flat walk.

Judges for the Retrieving stake are Jack Higgins of Lincoln, NE and Steve Short of Airdrie, Alberta. The Judges for the non-retrieving stake are Charles Parietti of Maryville, MO and Joe Luisi of Trenton, NJ.

**STAKES:**

Retrieving Championship - First series is a 30-minute multiple course. Second series is a 45- minute single course. Second series dogs called back at the judge's discretion. Retrieve is required in both stakes. All shooting will be on course.

Non-retrieving Championship - This is a single series stake utilizing multiple courses.

Horseback handling will be allowed in both stakes. Tracking collars and collaring allowed in both stakes. Bitches in season permitted in both stakes and when found in season will be redrawn to run at the end of the stake. **Both stakes to be judged on the AKC Gun Dog standard.**

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Open to all AKC registered pointing breeds that, within the past two years, have placed first in any AKC Amateur, Open, or Limited Open Gun Dog stake, or have place 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> in any AKC Amateur, Open, or Limited Gun Dog stake with at least 13, 18, or 25 starters respectively. Field Champions and Amateur Field Champions are also qualified to enter. Qualifying stakes do not have to be retrieving.
