Happy Hour: To be held Saturday Night at the Swift River Sportsmen's Club (1/2 mile away) at the conclusion of the day's running. Cash bar at the club. Please, no BYOB due to club rules.

Food: Lunch will be served at the Swift River Sportsmen's Club.

Camping: Camping is allowed in designated areas only. Please be aware that if conditions are muddy, horse trailer access may be difficult!

Horses: There will be no wrangler at this trial. Please ensure that your horse is secure at all times and clean up any manure piles. Please fill in all holes dug by dogs.

Directions to Trial: If you get lost, call my cell at 603-995-1733

From the Mass Pike (South of Trial Grounds)

Take Exit 8. Turn right at RT-32/Thorndike St. Take a quick right onto Lawrence Street. Go .7 miles and take left onto Shearer Street. Turn right onto Route 181 North. After about 5 miles, turn right on Michael Sears Road. Turn Right onto Cold Spring Road. You will pass the Swift River Sportsmen's Club (site of Hunting Test.) Take first left onto East Street and follow for $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. Look for small pond and house on right. The entrance to the trial is on left. Look for a dirt road and an open metal gate.

From Route 9 (North of Trial Grounds)

The grounds are between Belchertown center and Ware center, south of the Quabbin Reservoir and Route 9. Look for brown wooden state sign on Route 9. This is East Street. Follow this road 1.5 miles (past fish hatchery). Grounds are on the right, opposite a house and small pond on left. Look for a dirt road and an open metal gate.
