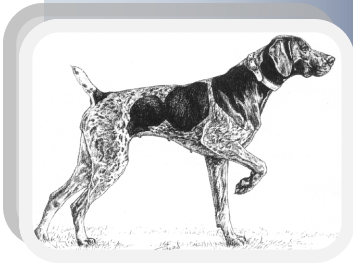

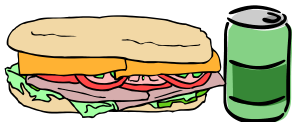
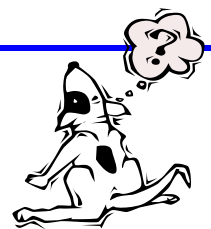

## THE ALL IMPORTANT DIRECTIONS

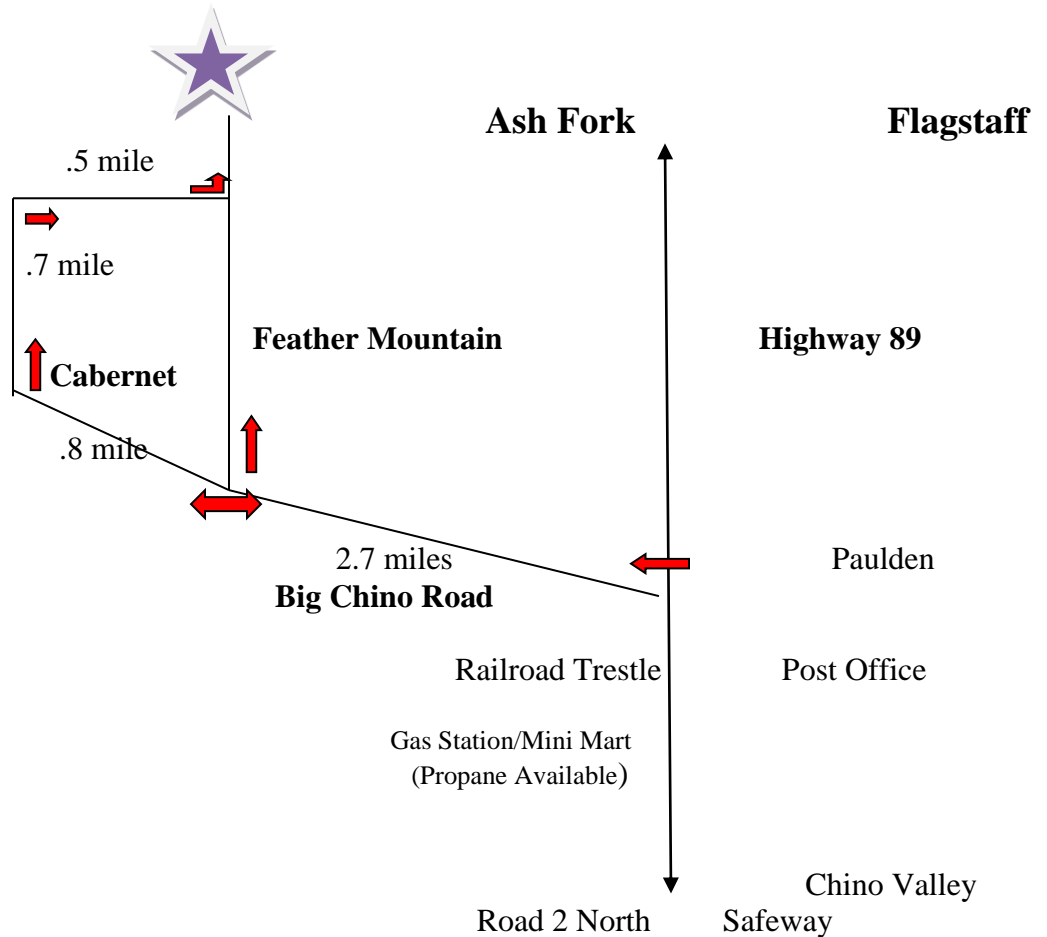

*From Flagstaff Area:*  
Take Hwy 89 South to Big Chino Rd (25 miles)  
Turn Right.

*From Phoenix/Tucson:*  
Take Hwy 89 North through Chino Valley to Big Chino Rd. (the first street under the railroad trestle). Turn Left.

Go west 2.7 miles to Feather Mountain Rd. Turn Right. This is a dirt road. Go about 2.2 miles to camp.

For those wanting a paved road:  
Go .8 mile past Feather Mountain to Cabernet. Turn right. Go another .7 mile to the "stop sign." Turn right. Go about .5 mile to the end of the paved road. This brings you back to Feather Mountain. Turn left. Camp is about .5 mile straight ahead.
