**Directions:** turn north on Forest Rd. 117 from Hwy 260 between Show Low and Springerville. FR 117 is approximately 3 miles east of the Sunrise turn off of hwy 260. Take FR 117 approximately 4 miles to Greens Peak, turn left onto FR 61 and go past Greens Peak until you cross a cattle guard with a corral on your left. Camp turnoff is 1 mile from cattle guard. Total distance on FR61 is approx. 5 miles. Note: forest roads are narrow gravel roads and edges can be soft after heavy rains.

**Lodging:** Eager-Springerville and the Show Low Lakeside, Pinetop areas have the most motels with restaurants and other services with in an hour to the trial grounds. Sunrise Lodge is the closest with limited space

and services. Greer also has a few with limited services.

Camping is permitted on trial grounds. No water is available on grounds for dogs or horses.

We are guests of the National Forest so rake out horse tie-outs, fill in dog holes, bag and haul out garbage. Camping area can be soft after heavy rains so stop on road and check parking areas before pulling in with heavy rigs.

Placements from Sunday's completed stakes will be presented after the days running.
