## Directions to Field Trial Grounds:

**From the North** – You must get on State Highway 5 at Lebanon.

**From Lebanon** – Go South on Mo Hwy 5 to Meadowlark Road. There is a large wooden silhouette of a Pointer on Mo-5 on the right. Turn Right onto Meadowlark. Follow it west until it swings south. The Sportsmen's Clubhouse and barns, etc. are a short distance south on the Right. If you drive all the way into Grovespring on MO-5; you have gone too far.

**From Grovespring:** Go to Mo Rt M and turn West. Go to Parks Creek Road (look for wooden silhouette of a Pointer on the right – not far past MFA Feed Store); turn Right and follow gravel road to the Clubhouse. There is one "Y" in the road – go to the right. Go past Andy Daugherty's house and kennel and continue down the valley to the clubhouse and stables (on the left).

**From the South** – From I-44 - Take Conway Exit, go to MO-5, turn R (south) and follow above directions. (There is no easy way from the South.)
