Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed.

- All dogs entered in the Bred -By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in his class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging.

Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Consult judging program for time of judging.

Grooming will be allowed in designated areas only.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

f, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

No unentered dogs allowed. All crates must be stackable, no tent crates.

The club will stack as they see fit. Crates and tables will not be allowed in the aisles of the show. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the crate/grooming section is not permitted.

A Grooming area will be roped off for the clubs holding specialties & supported entry.

No practicing in the rings at any time.

Veterinarian is on call. The exhibitor is responsible for cost and transportation of sick or injured dog.

From the East - 1-90 W toward Buffalo (portions toll) Merge onto 1-88 W, via Exit 25A toward RT-7/SCHENECTADY/BINGHAMTON (portions toll) Take the RT-205 W exit, Exit 13, toward Rt-23 W/ONEONTA/MORRIS. Turn right onto NY-205, turn SLIGHT LEFT onto NY-23, Turn LEFT onto Main St/NY-23/NY 51, Turn, RIGHT onto NY-23, Turn LEFT onto Silver St, Turn RIGHT onto E MAIN St, End at 61 E MAIN ST, on the RIGHT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
