## DIRECTIONS



From the East: Take I-90 to Albany and then Rt. 20 West for 4.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 146 West toward Altamont. Go 6 miles then bear right up the hill on Rt. 156 West. Go 3.7 miles and turn left on Co. Rt. 254 (Pleasant Valley Rd.). Go straight through the stop sign, continuing on Rt. 254. Go 4.1 miles to Rock Rd. The road comes to a "T". Turn left. Almost immediately, turn right on Rock Rd. (still Rt. 254). Go 1.3 miles and turn left onto Co. Rt. 1 (Switz Kill Rd.). There is a big green house on the right by the turn. Go straight through the next stop sign. Go .7 miles and turn right onto Co. Rt. 9 (Canaday Hill Rd.). Go 1.9 miles to stop sign and turn left onto Bradt Hollow Rd. Stay on this for 4.2 miles. It will become a gravel road.

From the West: Exit 23 on I-88. Go South on Rte. 30A. Go 2 miles (just past the Carrot Barn/Schoharie Farms) turn left onto Rt. 443. Go 7.7 miles and turn right onto Co. Rt. 9. Go 1.1 miles. Rt. 9 makes a 90° left turn. Go straight onto Bradt Hollow Rd. Stay on this for 4.2 miles. It will become a gravel road.

\*NOTE: Trial Headquarters is located at the intersection of Bradt Hollow Rd. & Cook Hill Rd.
