Spring 2011 Field Trial

The Michigan Brittany Club would like to welcome everyone to its Spring Field Trial. The trial will be held at the Ionia State Recreation Area, I-96 to Exit 67 (M66), North to David Hwy, West to Harwood, and North to Headquarters.

Entries for the field trial will close on **Tuesday, April 5, 2011** at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.

Placement in both Gun Dog Stakes will count toward the East Central Gun Dog of the Year Trophy.

This field trial will also be run as an American Field event. If your dog is registered with the American Field – Please include their FDSB registration number on the entry form and their color.

All horses on the grounds need current coggins and health certificates. Handler horses are not supplied by the Michigan Brittany Club. If you would like to make your own arrangements to rent a horse contact Will Langley, Bottom Creek Farm, at (810) 724-3426.

Dogs need a current rabies vaccination certificate.

Saturday Evening - Please plan on joining us for a happy hour and dinner at the conclusion of the day's running.

State Park Permit- The Michigan DNR requires all vehicles on State grounds to display a State Park sticker. These will be available for purchase at the grounds for \$6 / \$8 (resident/non-resident) daily permit or \$24/\$29 (resident/non-resident) annual permit.

Parking /Camping- Camping is permitted on Headquarter grounds. **Only campers desiring electricity should park in the area with electrical outlets.**

Camping fees (\$6 per day) are paid directly to the Michigan Brittany Club. Fees for an electrical hookup (\$4 per day) are also to be paid directly to the Michigan Brittany Club.

There is no parking anywhere along the park service road or highway. Use designated parking lots only. Park perpendicular to posts in the Headquarters Parking Lot. There is no parking in the middle of the lot.

Attention Field Trialers

The Ionia Field Trial Grounds Committee requests that you pay special attention to the following items to help us maintain our quality facility and reduce the time and labor involved in clean-up at the conclusion of the trial.

- v FILL IN ALL HOLES CAUSED BY DIGGING DOGS.
- v PICK UP ALL LOOSE PAPER AND OTHER TRASH THAT MAY BLOW INTO THE PARKING AREA AND SURROUNDING FENCED AREAS.
- v CLEAN ANY STALL YOU MAY USE AND DEPOSIT THE WASTE IN THE MANURE SPREADER.
- v CLEAN UP ALL HORSE MANURE AND HAY ASSOCIATED WITH YOUR ANIMALS AND DEPOSIT IT IN THE MANURE SPREADER.

Wheelbarrows, etc. are kept in the barn storeroom. Please return them upon completion of your cleaning.

In addition please pay close attention to the following:

- v PLEASE DO NOT CHAIN DOGS OR TIE HORSES TO THE FENCEPOST ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF THE PARKING LOT.
- v PARK HORSE TRAILERS AND CAMPERS BUTTED AGAINST THE PARKING LOT PERIMETER POSTS. DO NOT PARK PARALLEL TO THEM AS IT REDUCES THE SPACE AVAILABLE FOR PARKING.
- v ELECTRICITY IS AVAILABLE TO CAMPERS AT THE GROUNDS HEADQUARTERS AT A COST OF \$4.00 PER DAY. (FROM THE MBC ONLY – PLEASE PAY THE MBC DIRECTLY).
- v THE PARKING LOT WILL BE CLOSED AND LOCKED FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE FIELD TRIAL. IF YOU WISH TO REMAIN AT THE GROUNDS, MOVE YOUR CAMP TO THE HORSEMAN'S CAMPGROUND INSIDE THE PARK.

FINALLY, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE IONIA RECREATION AREA IS A MULTIPLE USE AREA. BICYCLE AND HORSEBACK RIDERS HAVE ACCESS TO THE MARKED TRAILS AND ROADWAYS. PLEASE BE POLITE IN CONVERSATION WITH THEM SO AS NOT TO CAUSE CONFLICTS. HUNTING IS ALSO ALLOWED ON ALL COURSES AND WE MUST KEEP IN MIND THAT WE ONLY HAVE ACCESS TO THE LAND JUST AS OTHERS DO.
