This field trial will also be run as an American Field event. If your dog is registered with the American Field – Please include their FDSB registration number on the entry form and their color (e.g. white and orange).

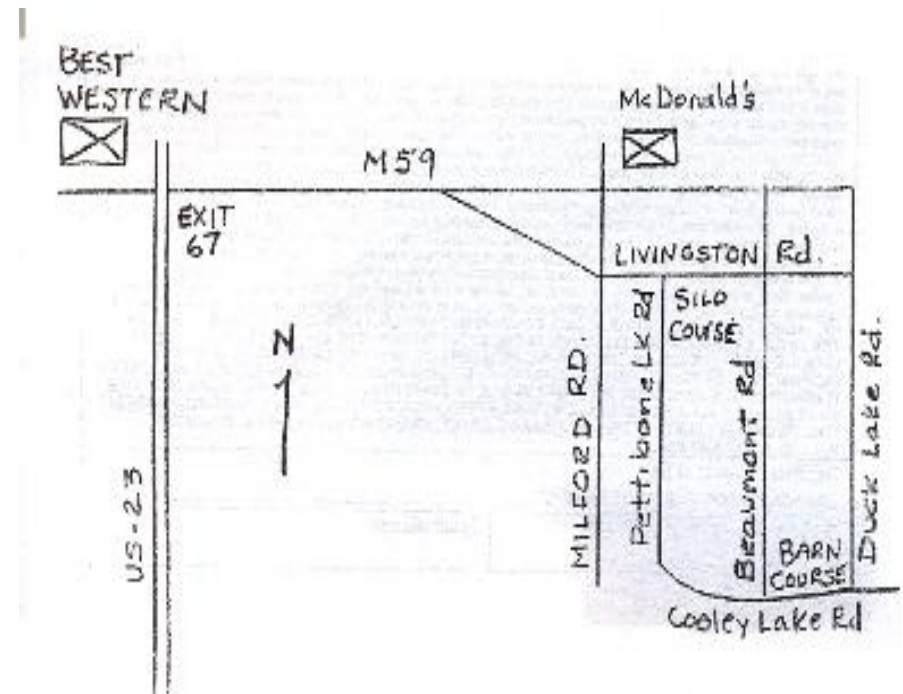
All horses on the grounds need current coggins and health certificates. No horses will be available for rent.
