All live shooting will be done by official gunners for Master and Senior Hunting Tests.

Horseback handling will not be allowed in any test.

Galleries must remain behind judges at all times.

Tracking Collars permitted but not provided.

DIRECTIONS: From I-75 proceed West on Hwy 52 to the intersection of Hwy 41 (approximately 11 miles). Turn right (North) on Hwy 41 and go approximately 6 miles and you will see field trial signs on the left. Go down the embankment, open the stock gate and follow road to Field Trial Grounds. Please be sure to close the stock gate behind you.

FOOD: Complimentary coffee and pastries will be provided by Mid-Florida Brittany Club, Inc. Saturday and Sunday morning. Lunch with drink will be provided each day. Water and sodas will be available for purchase. MFBC will provide veggie, potato and dessert for Saturday dinner. Bring your own drink, meat for the grill and a dish to share.

CAMPING: Hunting Test participants and spectators are welcome to camp on the Masaryktown Field Trial Grounds. No electric hookups are available. Water is available on the grounds. An outdoor, hot water shower is available. Please be responsible for your campsite, your dogs and horses. If you cook out on your own, be sure to keep your fire under control. Be sure your fire is completely out when you leave and your fire pit is completely cold. **Safety comes first!** Please respect your fellow campers and keep noise to a minimum at night; others may have to be up very early the next morning to run a dog.

AKC CANINE GOOD CITIZEN (CGC) TEST Sunday March 14, 2010

CGC is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

The Mid-Florida Brittany Club is offering Canine Good Citizen testing both Saturday and Sunday during Hunt Test hours starting at 8:00 AM.

The cost is \$10.00 per dog and the test is open to all dogs, both pure breed and mixed breed and there is no age requirement. Dogs do not need to be entered in the Hunt Test to participate in CGC Testing.

You can sign up for CGC at the Hunt Test Secretary's table. Testing will be conducted by Certified Tester, Bess Walmsley.

Many dog owners choose Canine Good Citizen training as the first step in training their dogs. The Canine Good Citizen Program lays the foundation for other AKC activities such as obedience, agility, tracking, and performance events. As you work with your dog to teach the CGC skills, you'll discover the many benefits and joys of training your dog. Training will enhance the bond between you and your dog. Dogs who have a solid obedience education are a joy to live with—they respond well to household routines, have good manners in the presence of people and other dogs, and they fully enjoy the company of the owner who took the time to provide training, intellectual stimulation, and a high quality life.
