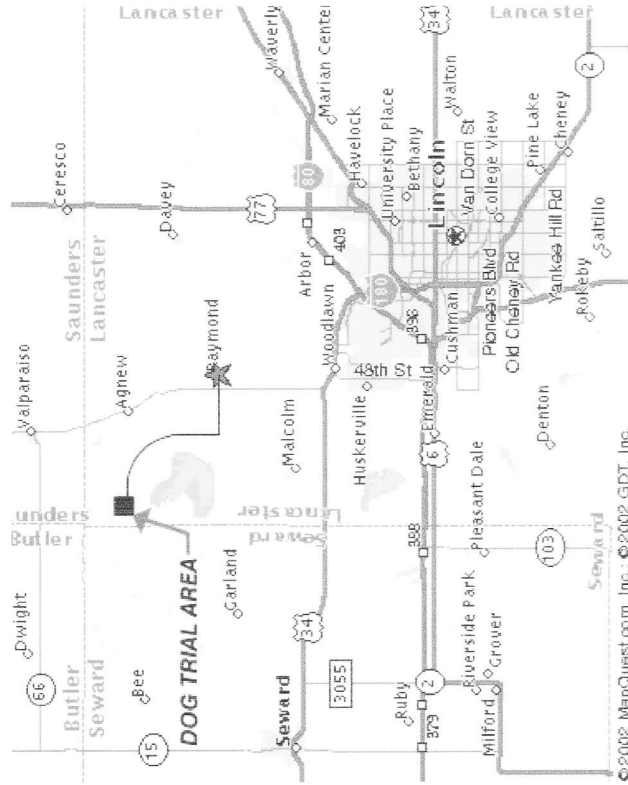

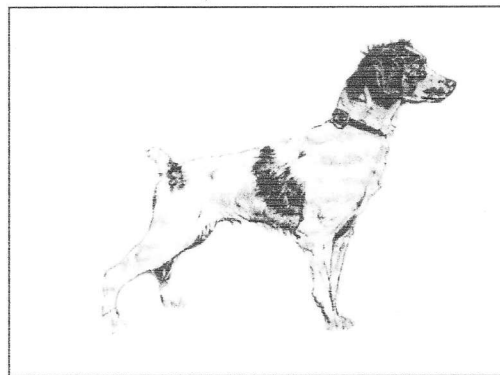

If paid later, the cost is \$6.00 per day. Campers are required to clean up after their animals and to leave the campground in the condition in which they found it or better.
