A blank gun will be fired in ALL stakes.
A blank cartridge will be fired in Open Puppy stake.
NO OPEN BARREL GUNS PERMITTED.

Bitches in season will be allowed in Open All Age and Am Gun Dog. They must be declared and will be run in last brace of each stake they are allowed to run in.

Horseback handling permitted in all stakes but rental horses will not be available.
Use of AKC approved tracking collars is permitted.

TRI VALLEY WILDLIFE AREA DIRECTIONS :

From I-70 take the State Route 93 Exit (Adamsville) North about 10 miles to the village of Adamsville. Continue North on State Route 208 and follow for approximately 4.6 miles to Keyes Road. Turn North (right) onto Keyes Road and follow for 1.4 miles to Stone Church Road.
Turn West (left) onto Stone Church Road and follow for 1.76 miles to entrance.

From State Route 16 take the State Route 60 South exit (Dresden). Follow SR 60 South for approximately 2.6 miles to State Route 208 at Dresden. Turn East (left) onto SR 208 and follow through the village. When you cross the bridge over the Muskingum River turn North onto SR 208. Follow SR 208 for 2.8 miles to McLaughlin Road (top of hill). Turn North East (left) onto McLaughlin Road and follow for .7 mile to Stone Church Road. Turn East (right) onto Stone Church Road and follow .4 mile to entrance

CAMPING:

Primitive Camping will be allowed on the grounds. There is water on the grounds but NO Water or Electrical Hookups.

ODNR has also advised that all parking MUST be on gravel surfaces....violaters will be ticketed.....no questions asked

The state also wants people with big rigs to park at the big lot at McClaughlin Rd while waiting for the grounds to open.

Ohio DNR rules require us to not be on the grounds any earlier than 4:00 PM on the date preceding the trial and we must leave before dark on the last day of the trial.

We have not made arrangements with any horse wrangler to be at this trial.
