(GPS coordinates, N41* 16' 09", W 079* 59' 09")

Entries will be accepted by mail or e-mail. No telephone entries!

Please fill out entries completely and don't forget to include your telephone number (home & cell) and e-mail address. Entry fees must be paid **before** you run your dog. We will only draw those dogs for which we have completed entries at the time of the closing.
