**Field Trial Information**

From the SW and I-81. Take the 64E exit to Charlottesville exit. Take 29N to Remington and turn right onto Rt 651, and follow the directions above to the field trial grounds.

**Camping:** Camping at the field trial grounds is permitted . Limited electrical hook-ups are available. Potable water is also available.

**Horses:** Rental horses **will not** be available.

**Motels:** All motels (Warrenton, Culpeper, and Fredericksburg) are approximately 30 minutes from the grounds.

**Food:** Lunch will be available on the grounds. A pot luck dinner will be provided on Saturday evening after the last brace of the day.

**Directions**

From I-95, exit onto 17N at Falmouth-Warrenton. Go approximately 12 miles to the Goldvein Store and Post Office on your right. Approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile past the store, turn left onto Rt 651. (A small sign says "Phelps Wildlife Management Area"). Stay on 651 for about 5 miles. The entrance to the grounds will be on your right. Look for the field trial sign.

From NW and I-81: Exit in Winchester onto Rt 50/Rt 17S. Stay on Rt 17 and Rt 29S past Warrenton. Stay on Rt 29S to Remington. To proceed to the field trial grounds continue thru the traffic light at the intersection of Rt 28. Go about 1 mile and turn left onto Rt 651. Continue on Rt 651 across the railroad tracks. Follow Rt 651 for about 5 miles. The grounds will be on your right immediately after crossing the bridge.
