GROUNDS: Due to the recent forest fires, the Forest Service is not yet issuing permits for grounds. This will probably be resolved by early next week, and I will send out another flier with the information. We will be either at the CC Cabin area or the Gillespie Flat area (where we were last year). Anything else that was being considered for us has burned!

FOOD: There is no food or water available on the grounds, so please bring your own. Water can be obtained at Hon-Dah Resort, Hoyer Campground in Greer, or RV resort in Springerville

COCKTAIL PARTY: We will have our usual cocktail party/placements on Saturday evening following the last braces of the day, usually about 5:30 or so. We will probably get together for placements on Friday, too, with whatever works out.

LODGING: The closest lodging is at the Sunrise Lodge, early reservations suggested. Otherwise, lodging is available in Springerville, Pinetop-Lakeside, and Greer.

PARTICIPANTS PLEASE NOTE:

This field trial has been designated an AKC Responsible Dog Ownership event!

Information regarding dog care, health, training and other aspects of responsible ownership will be available at the trial.

HORSES: Horseback handling permitted in all stakes. No rental horses will be available.

CAMPING: Will be permitted on the grounds. Porta-potties will be on the grounds. We will be on Forest Service land (somewhere!) and we are **REQUIRED** to haul out all our trash, close gates if necessary, and possibly move horse stake-outs to minimize the impact on the grounds. Before leaving the grounds, the Forest Service requests that you clean up your campsite by filling in dog holes, cleaning up or burying dog droppings, raking out horse stake-out areas, etc.

STARTING: Approximately 7:30 a.m. MST on Friday morning, September 2, 2011.

We look forward to seeing you at the trial!

Here is a map to Gillespie Flat area - hopefully this will be our location. If we end up at CC Cabin I will send out directions to that, but it is the same up to the last couple of turns in the road.
