

DIRECTIONS TO GROUNDS

From Memphis:

Take I40 East towards Nashville

Continue south on TN 385 until it ends at Macon Rd (TN 193)

Proceed east on TN 193 approx. ½ mile to Erb-Turley Farm

Turn left on to Farm road at the signs

From Nashville:

Take 140 West (approx 182 Miles)

Exit at TN 385 South

Continue south on TN 385 then follow (in bold)
directions as above.

From Jackson, Ms.

Take I55 North approximately 198 miles

Exit right at MS. 302 (Exit 289)

Proceed east on MS 302 past the city of Olive Branch

Turn left (north) onto MS 309 and proceed past the MS/TN line

Turn right onto TN 385 and proceed to the end at TN 57

Turn right and proceed to TN 196

Turn left onto TN 196 and proceed to TN 193 (Macon Rd.)
