These motels are a 35-40 minute drive from the Field Trial site.

\*\* See map for directions to test location. Faust Trail Grounds are 7.4 miles from the Faust turn off from ST HWY 73 (3 miles from the start of the dirt road). From I15 Exit 279 (Lehi) take main ST HWY 73 West past Eagle Mountain, thru Cedar Fort, past Camp Floyd State Park and past 5-Mile Rec. Area. Turn left at the Faust turn-off sign while on the paved road (.2 miles past the Toelle County Line). On the Faust Rd./Hwy 36, drive 4.4 miles and look for a dirt road turn off to the left (this will be near mile marker 9). Signs will be posted at this turn off. 3 miles south on this dirt road will be the test grounds, follow the signs  
\*\*\*.2 miles past the turn off, on the right hand side of the paved road is the back side of a "Safety Zone/No shooting sign. If you see it, you went just a little too far\*\*\*"
