Turn left onto Maguire Road and stay on it. Location of hunt test will be easily seen on the right.

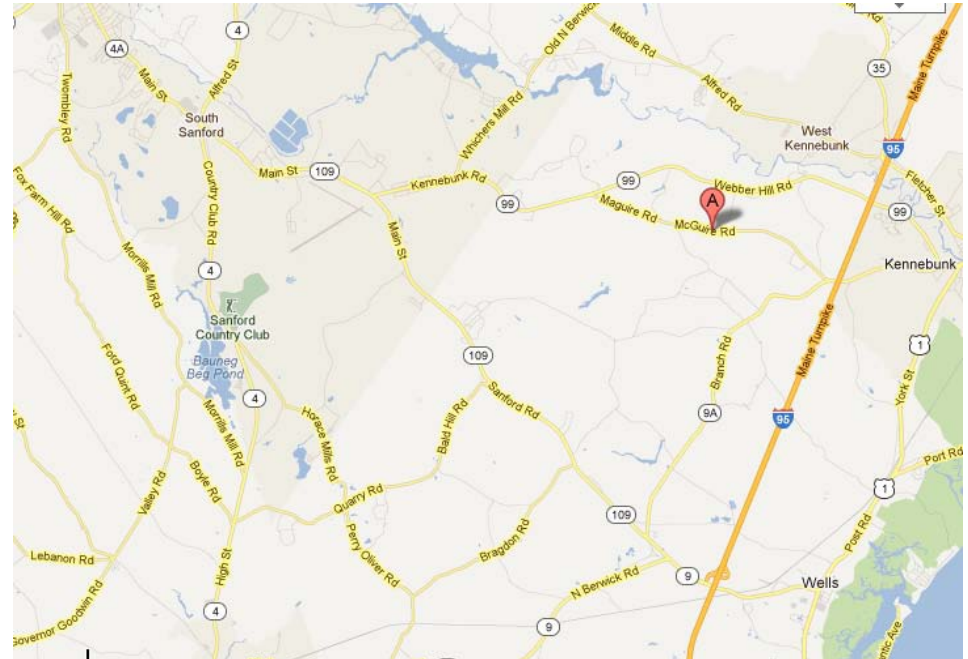

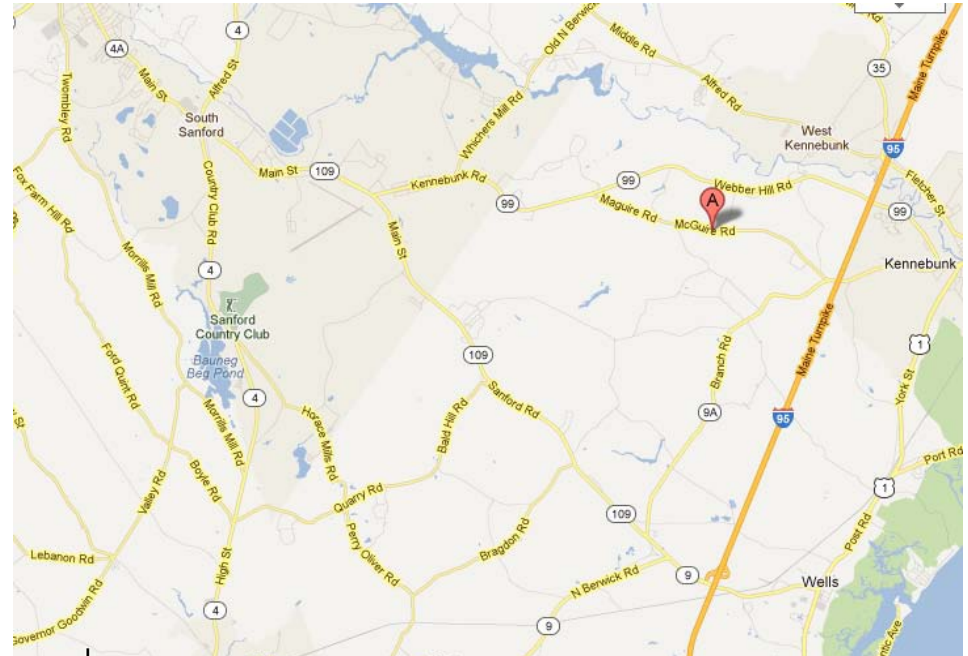
