

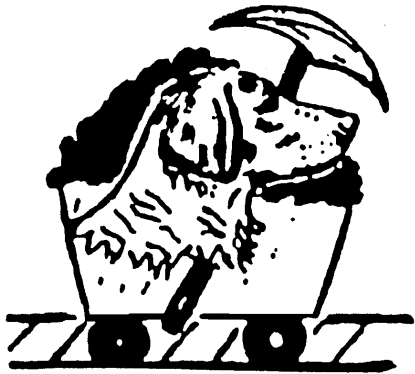

Non-Regular Classes involving Single Dog Entries

Field Trial – a class for dogs and a class for bitches which are Field Champions or Amateur Field Champions of record, or which have placed in an AKC licensed or member Field Trial during the past 12 months.

Hunting Test – a class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned an AKC Junior, Senior, or Master Hunter title.

Veteran – a class for dogs and a class for bitches 7 years and older.

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog - for dogs shown with at least two of his get. Owners of the dog need not own the get. The get must be entered in the Show in a Regular Class. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his get.

Brood Bitch - for bitches shown with at least two of their produce. Owners of bitch need not own produce. The produce must be entered in the Show in a Regular Class. The Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with her produce.

NOTE: Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes – Since the judge's decision in these classes are based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Sweepstakes Classes

Sweepstakes Classes are open to all Brittanys 6 months of age and under 18 months of age which are entered in a Regular Class in this Show. **Entry fee is \$12.00** for each Brittany entered in the Sweepstakes and is in addition to the entry fee for the Regular Class. Enter by writing "sweepstakes" under Additional Classes on the entry form.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOTE - Effective January 1, 2005

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 816-3776.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

AGREEMENT

I (We) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows/Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (We) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In considerations of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judges and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within reasonable time, please notify Show Secretary.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

NO DOGS will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the Show.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before the competition, no refund of entry fee will be made. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

RABIES VACCINATION NOTICE: To comply with Pennsylvania's Rabies Law, every dog on show grounds must have a current rabies vaccination certificate issued by a veterinarian.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted within 100 feet of the ring.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

From I-80: Take Exit 161 (from the East) or Exit 158 (from the West) onto PA Route 26 South to Pleasant Gap. Turn left onto Route 144 South through Centre Hall to Old Fort Intersection. Turn right onto Route 45 West approximately ½ mile to Fairgrounds on the right. Follow signs.

From the South: (Altoona) Take I-99 (Rt 220 North) to Rt 322 East. Turn right onto Rt 45 East at Boalsburg for approximately 8 mi. to Fairgrounds on on left. Note: Use Rt 26 for downtown State College, then Rt.322 East (business) for showgrounds.

From the East: (Harrisburg) Take Route 322 West to Route 144 North to Old Fort Intersection. Turn left on Route 45 West approximately ½ mile to fairgrounds on right.
