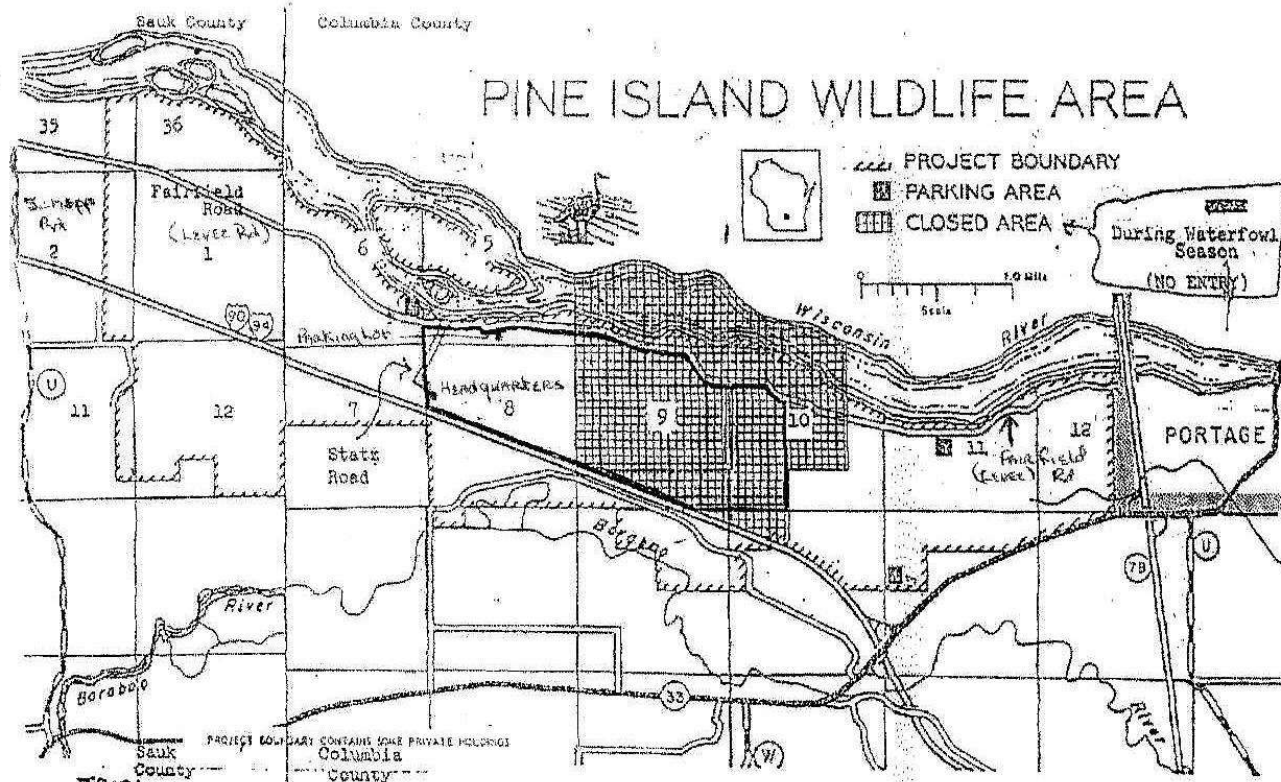

Directions

The following directions are for those traveling from the south. The easiest route is to take I90-I94 to I-39 to Hwy 33 East. Exit on Hwy 33 East to Fairfield (Levee) Rd. Turn left at Blystone Towing and continue on Fairfield to Statz Rd. Take Statz to the end. This is the location of the Pine Island Hdqtrs. Bldg. and is about 6 miles from Hwy 33-Fairfield intersection.

Big Rigs have found the underpass on Fairfield (Levee Rd.) to be uncomfortably low. They have chosen to continue on I90-I94 to Hwy 33. They exit at Hwy 33 and go west over the Baraboo River. Just past the river, they turn right on Cty Hwy U. They continue north. Where Cty Hwy U junctions with Schepp Rd., they take Schepp Rd. north to Levee (Fairfield) Rd. They turn right on Levee Rd. and travel approximately 4 miles to Statz Rd. Turn right on Statz to the Headquarters Building.

Construction Note: They have closed one lane of the Interstate in both directions between De Forest and Poynette. You might want to take Hwy 51 north of Madison to Portage.

- Section 9 - West one-half, north of Interstate Highway 90-94 (except during fall Waterfowl season when Section 9 is a "closed area" no entry is permitted)
- Section 10 - West one-half, north of Interstate Highway 90-94 (except during fall Waterfowl season when Section 10 is a "closed area" no entry is permitted).
