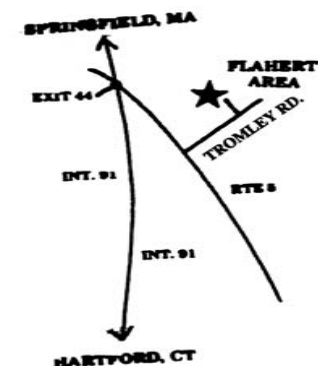
CENTRAL NEW ENGLAND BRITTANY CLUB FALL FIELD TRIAL SEPT 19 & 20, 2009

Please note the following information:

- Camping is permitted but there are no hookups and water is not available.
- **There will be a wrangler at this trial.** Handlers are to make their own arrangements for horses. **Both walking and horseback handlers are permitted in open stakes.**
- Food will be available both Saturday and Sunday.
- The club requests that dogs not be left on a stakeout chain unless someone is to be in the immediate vicinity. Please be sure that all horses are properly secured after the day's running.
- Happy hour after the last brace on Saturday. Food donations gratefully accepted!
