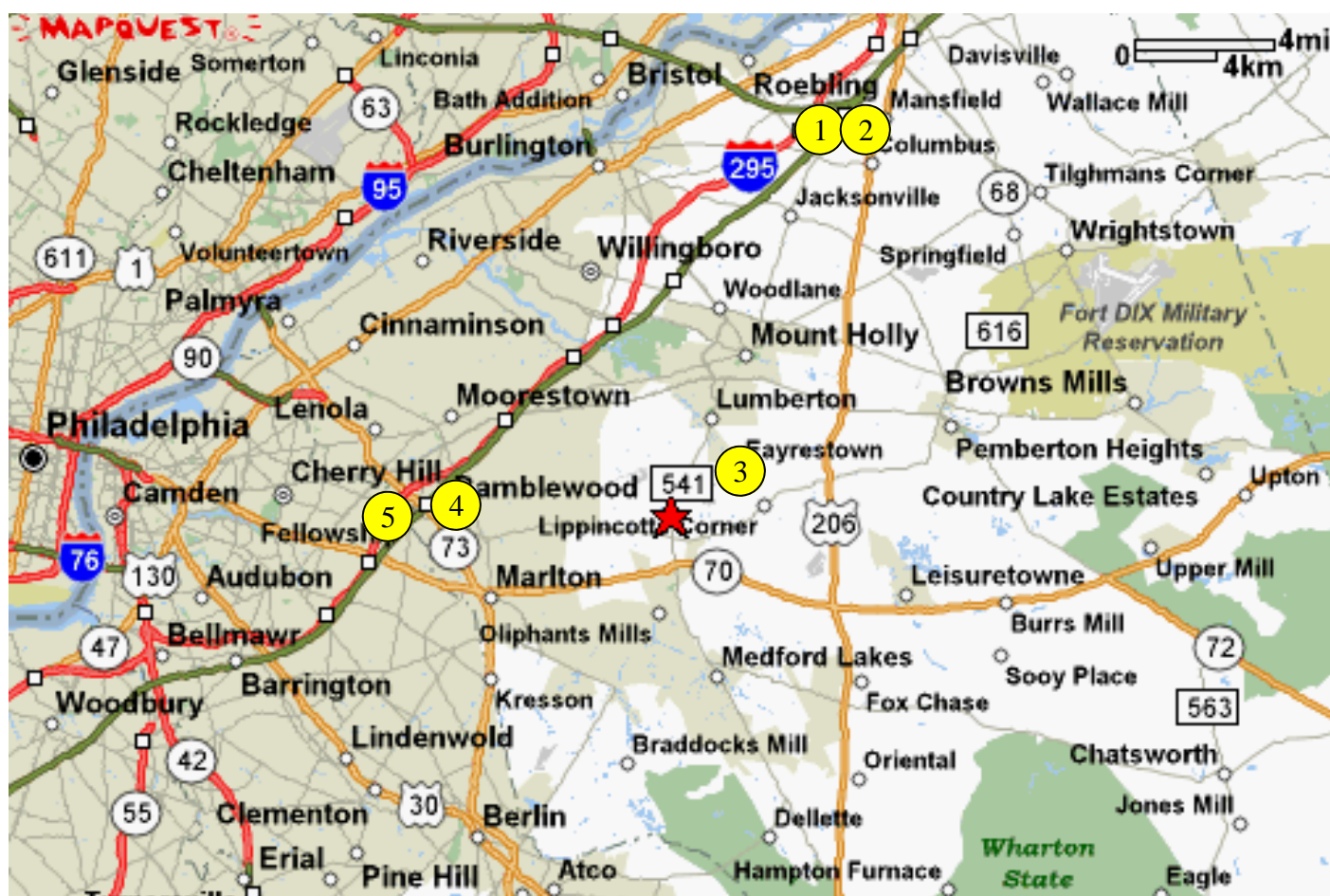

**DIRECTIONS**

The English Setter Club is located on Route 541 between Lumberton and Medford. From the North, take the NJ Turnpike to Exit 5, turn right out of the exit and follow Rt 541 thru Lumberton. Watch for the English Setter Club driveway on the right immediately after the soccer field. From the West, take the Pennsylvania Turnpike east to the NJ Turnpike south, Exit 5, then see above. From the South, use I-295 or the NJ Turnpike. Take exit 4 from the Turnpike onto Rt 73 south, then east on Rt 70 (from I-295, exit at Rt 70). Follow Rt 70 east to Rt 541 (Medford) intersection and turn left onto Rt 541 north. The English Setter Club will be on your left side, just after the tack shop.
