

FIELD TRIAL/HUNTING TEST PREMIUM LIST

At the April 1998 meeting, the American Kennel Club board of Directors approved the use of tracking collars at Pointing Breed Field Trials; effective date September 1, 1998.

Their use will be permitted at this trial, in all stakes

The rules regarding using a tracking collar at an AKC licensed or sanctioned event are:

1. Only AKC approved collars may be used. Model numbers will change as technology changes and improved models become available. The models currently approved by the AKC for use at AKC events are:
 - Wildlife Materials #2850 & #2300 & #3850
 - LL Electronics LD#3 & CS#1
 - Tracker FTV466
 - Tracker FTL998
2. The radio transmitter placed on the dog is to weigh no more than five (5) ounces.
3. If a handler elects to use the transmitting collar on his or her dog, only one other identification-type collar is permitted to be on the dog. The tracking collar shall remain on the dog during the entire heat; if a handler elects to remove the tracking collar, that dog shall be considered out of judgment.
4. The handheld locating receiver can only be used after the dog is determined to be out of judgement.
5. The use of the tracking collar is elective and for no reason should the running of a stake be held up due to lack of available equipment.
6. Each club shall provide the judges with a copy of this page concerning the use of tracking collars at the AKC Pointing Breed Field Trials.
7. Any person using a locating receiver to locate a dog currently in judgment, and prior to official authorization of its use by one of the judges, shall disqualify the dog in that stake and the offenders shall be disqualified from the field trial.
8. Special Training Collars used to control and train dogs including but not limited to collars with prongs, electronic collars used with transmitters, muzzles and head collars may not be used on dogs at AKC events, except as allowed in the AKC Rules, Regulations and Policies.

ENEBC cordially invites you to attend it's fall trial to be held at the Crane Wildlife Management Area, Route 151, No. Falmouth, MA on October 6-7, 2007. **Please note: This is a walking trial and horseback handling will not be permitted in any stake.**

No limitations apply to this trial. That means that all entries will be accepted, but the club reserves the right to re-arrange the running order as conditions warrant. We will attempt to keep everybody abreast of any running order changes, but please be advised that it is your responsibility to call for bracing and any running order changes.

Entries: Phone entries (508/432-1892) will be accepted. Entries may also be snail mailed to the FT secretary or e-mailed to "obearse@comcast.net". Paperwork and fees must be submitted before any dog is run. Bracing information will be available after 9:30 P.M., Wednesday, October 3, 2007. Please make all checks payable to "Judith Wessling-ENEBC".

Walking Hunting Dog: Time permitting, an Amateur Walking Hunting Dog stake will be run on Sunday, in addition to the Saturday Walking Hunting Dog stake.

TRACKING COLLARS: Their use will be permitted at this trial. Only the AKC-approved collars (Wildlife Materials #2850, #2300 & #3850; LL Electronics LD#3 & CS#1; Tracker FTV 466 & FTL 998 may be used. See reverse side of entry form for rules governing their use.

NOTE: For no reason whatsoever will the running of a stake be held up due to the lack of available equipment at the time a dog is called to the line.

Reminder: Except for water for horses and on the course for the dogs, water is not available on the grounds.

Food: Breakfast and lunch will be available both days.

Happy Hour: A hospitality hour hosted by the members of the Eastern New England Brittany Club will be held on the grounds at the conclusion of Saturday's running.

Grouse/Woodcock Competitions from a Judging Perspective: Also at the conclusion of Saturday's running, ENEBC will hold a presentation about the Grouse and Woodcock competitions that are becoming more popular amongst the walking handlers. This will be your opportunity to find out all about them, the equipment required, the preparation/training involved, what judges are looking for, etc. Unless we can find a likely person to conduct this presentation, Pat Carney of Danvers, MA will be doing the talking.
