Firearms: .22 or .32 caliber blanks or larger must be used and only manufactured solid barrel firearms, with blank shells or crimps, which prevent a projectile of any kind from leaving the barrel, permitted.

Tracking Collars permitted in accordance with AKC guidelines.

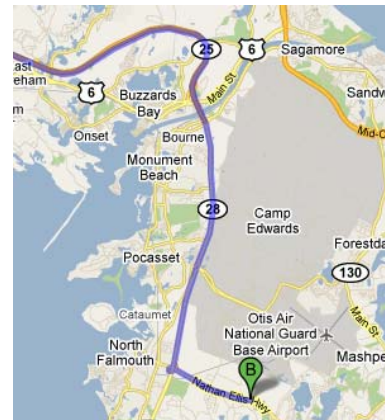

- The club requests that dogs not be left on a stakeout chain unless someone is to be in the immediate vicinity. Please be sure that all horses are properly secured after the day's running.
- Happy hour after the last brace on Saturday. Food donations gratefully accepted!
