DIRECTIONS

From I-75 going north from the Atlanta area.

Take I-75 North to Exit 290-Hwy 20. There is a light at the end of the ramp. At the light, turn left (west) going under I-75 on Hwy 20 to where it dead-ends at another traffic light. (Approx. 2.3 miles.)

Turn Left and make an immediate right onto 411 South/20 West. Follow that straight for approximately 3 miles (right after light at Conoco gas station), to where it cuts off to the right. Keep following the signs to 411 South/20 West. It will say to Kingston/Rome area.

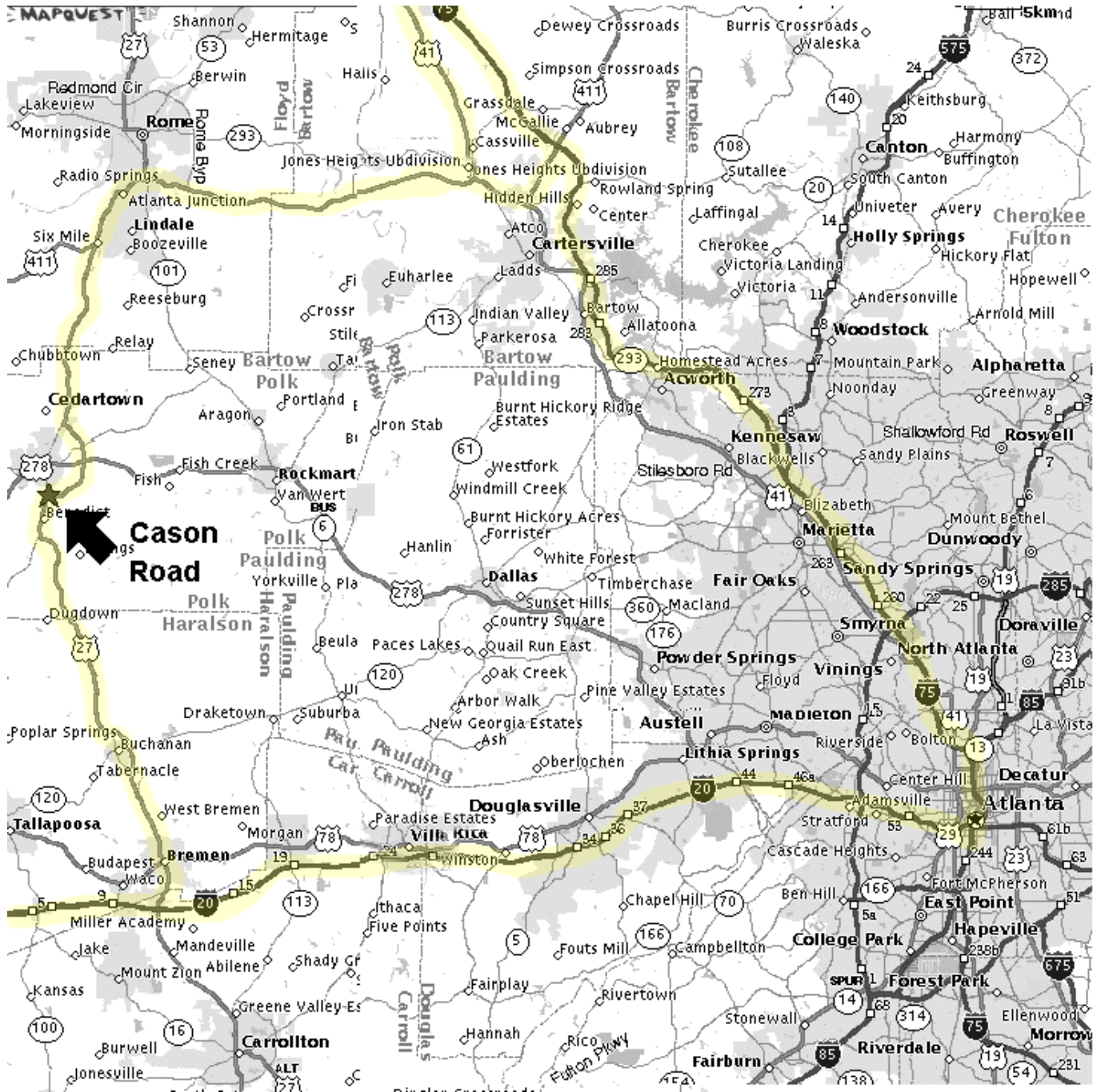
Stay on 411 South/20 West for 22 miles, going towards Rome. You will then pass a Chevy dealership on your left. Right after that, exit left to 411/53/27 South to Cedartown. Go 4.2 miles on 411/53/27 until 411/53 splits off.

Continue straight on Hwy 27 South to Cedartown (411/53 will split off to the right). Continue another 9 miles towards Cedartown, until you see a Wal-Mart on the left. Take a left at the traffic light past Wal-Mart, on Hwy 27 South.

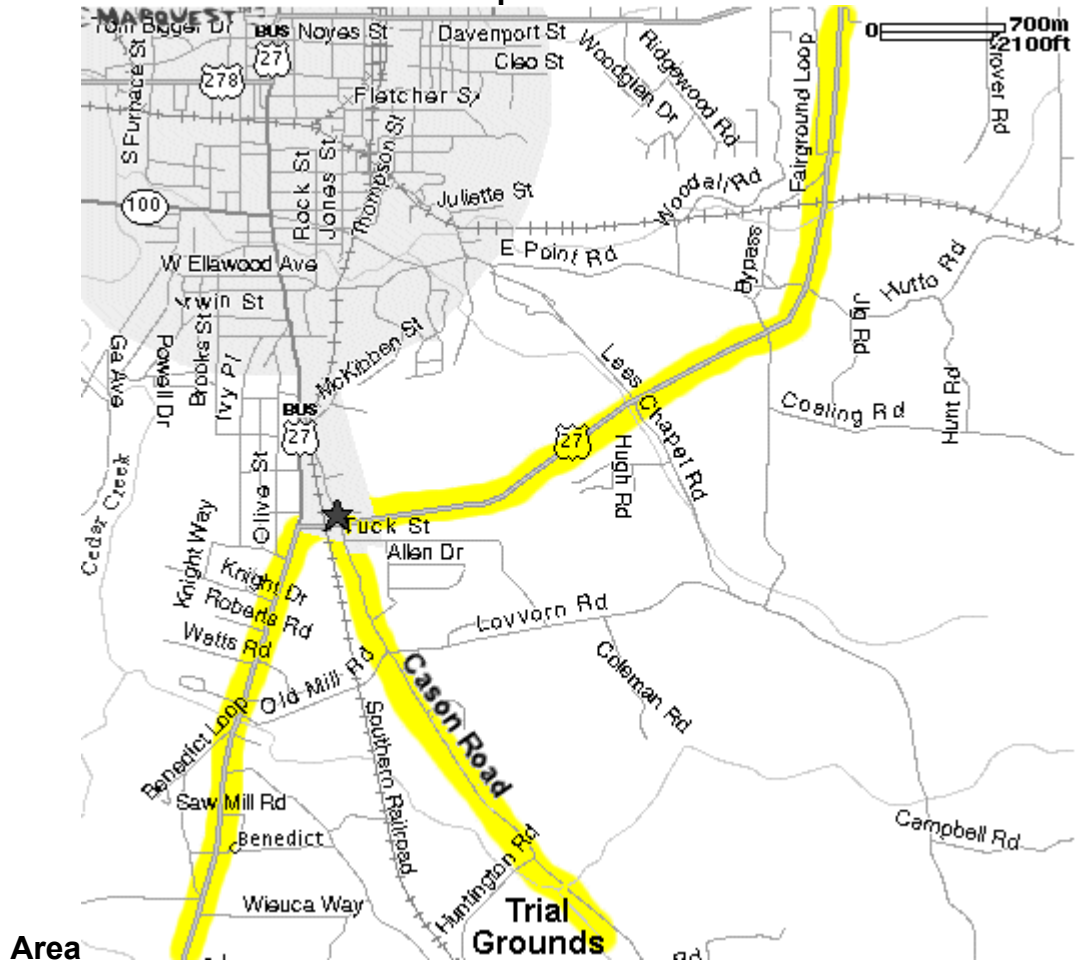
Follow Hwy 27 South approximately 5 miles to Cason Road. At Cason Road, turn left and go approximately 4.5 miles to the J.L. Lester Wildlife Management area, on the right.

Please use the second entrance to enter, due to the sharp turn to the grounds. Proceed down the driveway past a barn and turn to your left to the parking area.

HOTELS:

Country Hearth

Direction to the Hotels from the Grounds:

Take Cason Road and turn left back to Hwy 27 (Approx. 4.3 miles) stop at the stop sign and turn right back like the way you came in. Go approx. 5 miles to where you reach Bus. 27 South, turn left there at the light, as if you heading into the town of Cedartown. Go less than a mile down to a traffic light (John Hand Drive). On the left will be Holiday Inn Express and a little further down on the right hand side will be the Country Hearth Inn.

CAMPING:

Camping on the grounds will be allowed. There are no hook ups or dump tanks available.

WATER:

Water for dogs and horses will be available on the grounds.
Bring your own water for human consumption.
