AKC approved tracking collars permitted for use under AKC Rules & Regulations but will not be supplied by the Greater St. Louis Brittany Club.
HORSEBACK HANDLING PERMITTED in ALL STAKES. Horses will NOT be provided by the Greater St. Louis Brittany Club.

ALL STAKES – Course 1 is a continuous course without bird field. Course 2 is a single course without a bird field.

Native and/or released Quail will be available in all stakes except Open Puppy.

Only Blank Guns with CLOSED BARRELS are permitted. Shots will not be fired in the Puppy stake.

Club reserves the right to limit entries to the number of dogs that can be run during available daylight hours. Club further reserves the right to adjust the running order, start time, or sequence of stakes depending on number of entries and conditions.

PRIZES

Standard AKC Rosettes to all placed dogs

Trophy to First placed dogs in each stake.

Purse in Open Limited All Age: 40% of entry fees returned from this stake, less grounds fees, split 40-30-20-10 to placing dogs

The winner of the Amateur All Age receives the Roy Quick Award, a traveling trophy, plus name engraved on a permanent plaque in the clubhouse.

[Directions to Field Trial Grounds:](#)

From the North – You must get on State Highway 5 at Lebanon.

From Lebanon – Take Mo Hwy 5 south to Meadowlark Road. There is a large wooden silhouette of a Pointer on MO-5 on the right. Turn Right onto Meadowlark. Go west and angle right at the “Y” in the road. Stay on this road until it crosses a creek. Clubhouse & barns, etc. are a short distance ahead on the right. If you drive all the way into Grovespring on MO-5 you have gone too far.

From Grovespring: Go to MO Rt M and turn West. Go to Parks Creek Road (look for wooden silhouette of a Pointer on the right – not far past MFA Feed Store); turn Right and follow gravel road to the Clubhouse. There is one “Y” in the road – go to the right. Go past Andy Daugherty’s house and kennel and continue down the valley to the clubhouse and stables (on the left).

From the South – From I-44 - Take Conway Exit, go to MO-5, turn R (south) and follow above directions. (There is no easy way from the South.)
