# INFORMATION & DIRECTIONS

## DIRECTIONS

Eastbound on Interstate 10 from Tucson, exit at Hwy 83. (About 20 miles from Tucson)

Go South to Sonoita approximately 25 miles.

Turn left (east) on Hwy 82. Go approximately 3.8 miles.

Look for the sign that says *EMPIRE CIENEGA RESOURCE AREA*.

This is the south entrance. It is Road 900.

We will also have a “*GCBC*” sign posted on the Highway.

Turn left (north) onto the gravel road. Go approximately 2.5 miles.

This is a rocky bumpy road. Drive slowly and carefully.

Look for our Campground on the left. There will be a large white tent.

This is the “*Road Canyon*” site for the trial.

Road Canyon is at the “intersection” of Roads 900 and 916.

All horse manure and dog waste must be cleaned up. There will be a trash bin provided by BLM for this purpose. For your convenience, we plan to have our own “street maintenance service” make pick ups at each camp.

Before leaving, make sure your area is clean.

Fill in dog holes, rake out all stake outs, pack all trash.

A Porta-Potty will be available as well as water for dogs and horses.

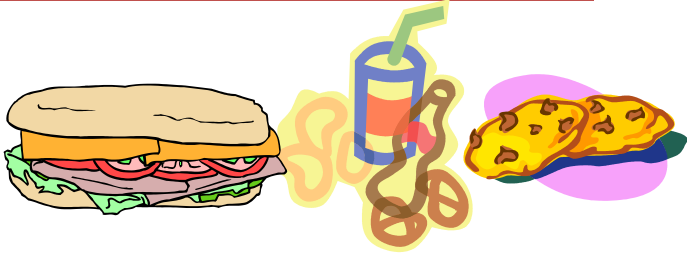

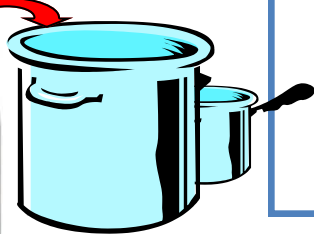
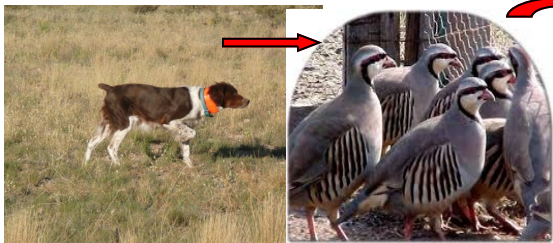
