

TRACKING COLLARS

At the April 1998 meeting, the American Kennel Club board of Directors approved the use of tracking collars at Pointing Breed Field Trials, effective date September 1, 1998. Their use will be permitted at this trial in all stakes.

The rules regarding using a tracking collar at an AKC licensed or sanctioned event are:
1. Only AKC approved collars may be used. Model numbers will change as technology changes and improved models become available. The models currently approved by the AKC for use at AKC events are:

Wildlife Materials #3850 , Marshall Powerpoint HP, QT-PD Pointing Dog

LL Electronics LD-3 & CS-4

Tracker Super Lite (TTA-100), Tracker Strike (TTA-170)

2. The hand-held "locating" receiver shall be kept in the possession of the judge, or their designee.

3. The hand-held "locating" receiver may only be used after the dog is determined to be out of judgment and no longer eligible for placement.

4. The use of the tracking collar is optional for both clubs and handlers.

FOR NO REASON WHATSOEVER WILL THE RUNNING OF A STAKE BE HELD UP DUE TO THE LACK OF AVAILABLE EQUIPMENT AT THE TIME A DOG IS CALLED TO THE LINE.

5. Judges will be informed by the Trial Secretary of the rules regarding the use of tracking collars to ensure uniform practice. Be prepared to remove the tracking collar from your dog for examination by the judge prior to running. If your collar is deemed acceptable, you will be instructed to re-collar your dog and hand over the locator to the judge.

6. Any person using a locating receiver to locate a dog currently in judgment, and prior to official authorization of its use by one of the judges, shall be disqualified from further participation in that stake; the dog is also disqualified.

From I-88 Sidney/Masonville Exit 9
Turn North on Rte. 8 3.4 miles to East Guilford turn LEFT at flashing light onto Co. Rte 35 headed WEST towards Guilford
14.4 miles turn RIGHT onto Rte. 12 NORTH 1.2 miles turn LEFT onto Turner St. (Stone House Automotive on corner) turns into a dirt road
3.4 miles turn LEFT at stop sign onto Preston Center Road.

You are HERE! Parking on LEFT past dirt driveway . Please keep bigger trailers in the graveled area and please don't park in feed strips.

ALL PAPERWORK AND FEES MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY BEFORE DOG IS RUN. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please keep in mind that we are running 8 stakes in two days and that there are only so many available daylight hours. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received.

Overnight camping is allowed and you may stay on Sunday evening.
However, please NOTE: The landowners have expressed a wish that no training occur on the grounds prior to or after the trial. We need to keep these grounds so please be considerate.

Wrangler will be Wayne Skubilec of PA. Handlers are to make their own arrangements for horses.

IMPORTANT: Please clean up after your horses and leave your area clean after you leave. Manure piles, hay & straw should be raked smooth/scattered and any holes filled in.
