Illinois Brittany Club Walking Trial
TWO PAWS DOG TRAINING CLUB
APRIL 28-MAY 1, 2011

Welcome to the 17th annual Illinois Brittany Club AKC/American Field Walking Trial. This trial is being held to benefit the championship organizations in our general geographic area. This year's trial will benefit the Prairie State Brittany Championship Association, the Illinois Brittany Championship Association, the Mid-South Brittany Championship Association and the Michigan Brittany Championship Association. (If any of these organizations does not hold a championship event next year, the proceeds will be split among the other Associations). To date, we have contributed a total of approximately \$37,500 to these organizations.

All placements will receive points toward the Illinois Dog of the Year Awards sponsored by Field Trial Clubs of Illinois. In addition, placements in the one hour Open Limited Gun Dog Stake will earn points toward the TriTronics Award and the Magnum's Masked Man Award.

Those judging for us are doing so at their own expense. Please be sure to express your appreciation to them for their efforts. We will need volunteers to help with bird planting and other tasks.

Parking will be a problem if the ground is wet. If we have heavy rains in the week preceding the trial, please do not bring horses or motor homes unless you are judging or marshalling. If we do have problems with wet ground and you need to park on the main road, park on the west side and pull off the road as far as possible.

Lunch will be available at the grounds. Be sure to bring your lawn chairs, portable tables and coolers. We'll enjoy a fun weekend and see some real great bird work in the bird field.

Motels are located at exit #72 (Mendota/Earlville) on Interstate 39/51. Super 8's # is 815-539-7429 and Comfort Inn's # is 815-538-3355. There is also a Buster's Truck Stop at the same exit with a 24-hour restaurant.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH, SOUTH OR WEST:

Take Interstate 39/51 to exit 82(Paw Paw exit).

Take exit 82 and go east to the town of Paw Paw. You are on Chicago Road. Take Chicago Road through town past Casey's Gas Station approximately two miles to East Paw Paw Road. Turn right or south. Two Paws Dog Training Club is just past the first house on the right.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE EAST

Take Rt. 47 to Route 30 through Hinckley about six miles to Route 23 (restaurant and flashing light on corner); turn left or south for approximately 4 and ½ miles to Chicago Road. Turn right and go until you cross railroad tracks and come to a T intersection (about 7 miles). Turn left and continue on Chicago Road approximately 3 miles and then turn left or south on East Paw Paw Road. Two Paws Dog Training Club is just past the first house on the right.
