The Iowa Brittany Club extends an invitation to you to attend the Fall, 2011 Field Trial held at Union County Bird Dog Ranch, two miles south and one mile west of Thayer, Iowa.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TRIAL BEGINS ON SATURDAY AND RUNS THROUGH MONDAY. Check enclosed premium for order of running. This trial is followed by the ABC Gun Dog Classic/Championship, which begins Tuesday morning on the same grounds.

This trial is licensed by the AKC and recognized by the American Field and Amateur Field Trial Clubs of America. Your dog does not have to be registered in the Field Dog Stud Book to compete, but only dogs with FDSB registrations will be recognized as qualifying at this trial to run in American Field championships.

Parking and stake-outs are permitted in the main campground area and the area immediately north of the big pines. **ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED AND NO HORSES STAKED OUT ON CRP GROUND.** Unauthorized vehicles are not allowed anywhere on the course (including the breakaway areas). Parking is permitted on the concrete slab, but please allow room for others to get in and out and access to the bird pen.

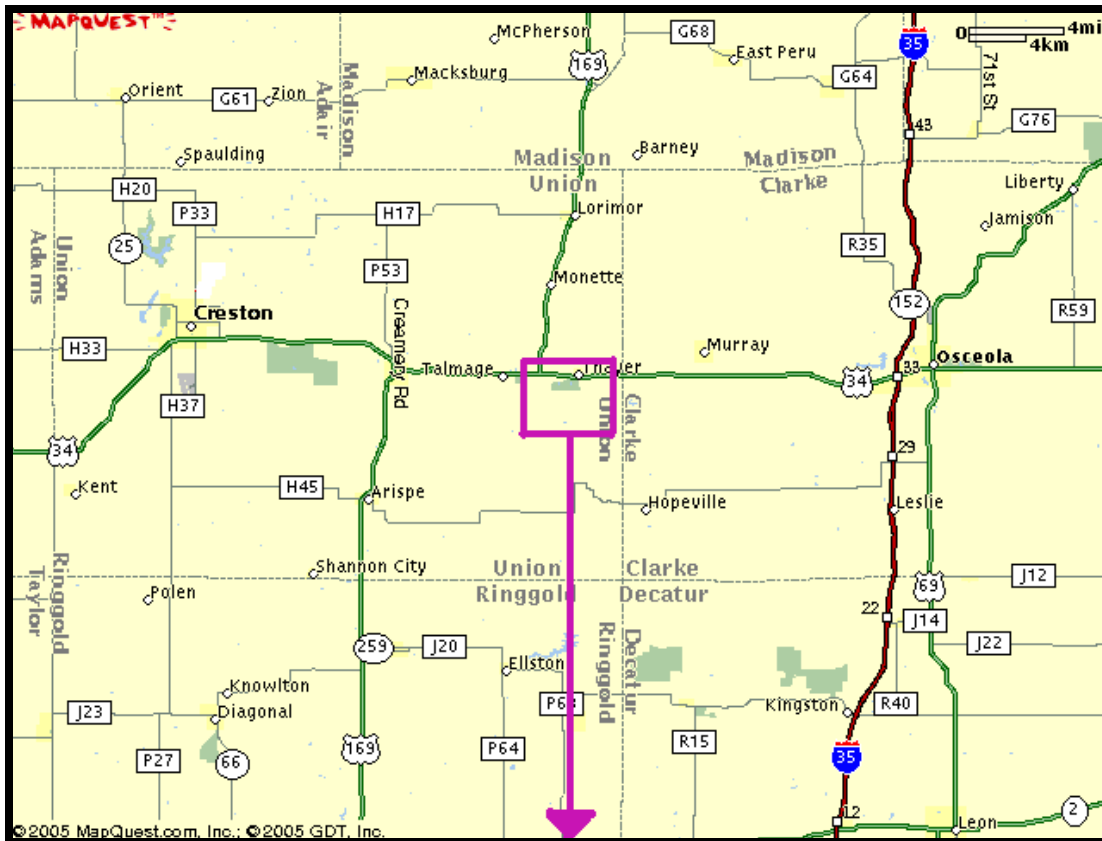
CAMPING: Primitive camping on the grounds. Electrical hookups are available at Thayer Lake Park, approximately 1-1/2 miles northwest of the grounds.
