Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties (or damage because of bodily injuries, including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Horses will not be furnished by the club. A few stalls are available in the barn. The corrals are finished and stakeouts are permitted in the designated areas.

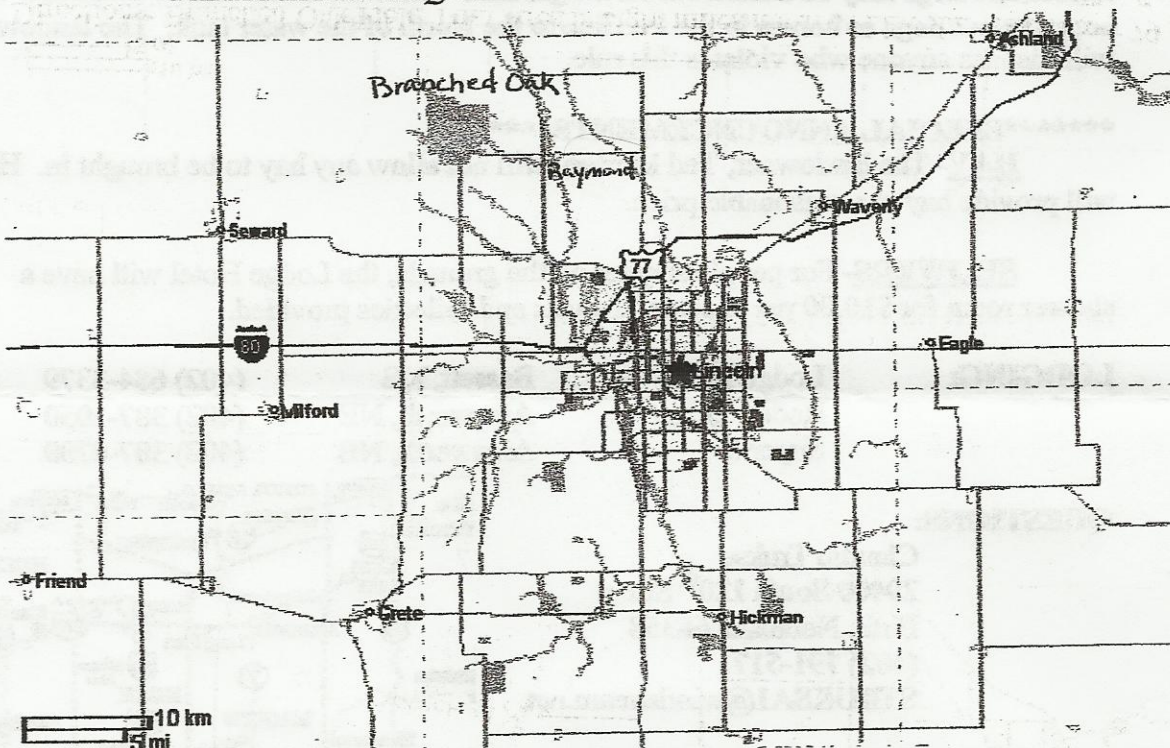
