A blank cartridge will not be fired in Puppy Stakes.
Northern Bobwhite Quail and/or Chukar Partridge released for all other stakes. Native woodcock & grouse may be encountered.

TRACKING COLLARS

As of August 1, 2009, the American Kennel Club Board of Directors updated the regulations for tracking collars at Pointing Breed Field Trials; Their use will be permitted at this trial, in all stakes. SPECIAL NOTE: GPS tracking collars manufactured by Garmin have been approved by AKC and will be allowed in all stakes.

The handheld receiver shall be kept in the possession of the judges or the marshal only. The handheld locating receiver can only be used after the dog is determined to be out of judgment. The use of the tracking collar is elective and for no reason should the running of a stake be held up due to the lack of available equipment.

Any person using a locating receiver to locate a dog currently in judgment and prior to official authorization of its use by one of the judges, shall disqualify the dog in that stake and the offenders shall be disqualified from that field trial.

- **Water is available on the courses for dogs and horses, but, there is no potable water on the grounds.**
- **Please do not leave dogs on stakeouts unattended during the field trial stakes. Please be sure that all horses are secured after the days running.**
- **Gates to the Field Trial Grounds will be closed in the evening. Please keep this in mind as you leave the grounds on Saturday night. Talk to Keith Madden for instructions.**
- **Breakfast and lunch will be available at a small cost. There will be a happy hour and chuck wagon dinner served Chef Johnny Poland featuring his famous mystery meat after the running on Saturday. Your food contribution and dog stories are welcome, but not required!**
- **There will NOT be a Wrangler at this trial. Handlers must arrange for own use of a horse if so desired.**
- **If you have a large rig, i.e. motor home or pulling a long horse trailer, it would be best to enter grounds using the Lower Gate.**
