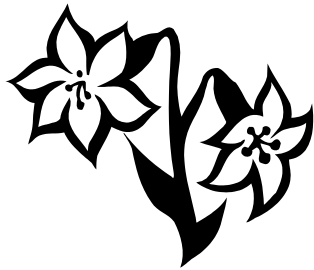


Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge (excluding a bitch in season), or barred from competition by action of the event's field trial committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcements or of the owner(s) of the grounds and /or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of dogs, trialers and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the trial before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. Any exceptions to such conditions must be approved by unanimous decision of the field trial committee.

This will be an improved dirt road that veers right at the orange pheasant sign. Stay on this improved road heading west to the clubhouse.
