This year our spring field trial precedes the ABC Eastern Futurity so we are looking forward to welcoming some new faces to the event along with those who have supported our trial for many years.

Due to the large number of rigs expected, we ask everyone to cooperate by parking as directed. In order to accommodate as many campers as possible, all camping spots will be marked. **Please contact Sue Lehosky, [sue@ellinc.com](mailto:sue@ellinc.com), 724-339-4616 if you are planning to camp.** You will be directed to a spot and must contain your setup in the designated area. A limited number of electrical hook-ups are available. Please bring extension cords and a generator to use if electric can't be provided. **There is a \$5 per day fee for camping on the grounds.** Those not using electric will not be charged. **Please read the additional instructions pertaining to the grounds and setup included.**

**Directions:** I-80 to Route 8, Barkeyville exit. Go north on Route 8, make a left onto old Route 8 toward Wesley. Go 1.5 miles, through Wesley, to SR 3003, turn left (west) and go one mile to SR 3011 (a Y) and turn right. Go 1.9 miles to Kerr Road on left. Follow Kerr Road to grounds on left, 256 Kerr Road. (GPS coordinates, N41° 16' 09", W 079° 59' 09")

**Entries will be accepted by mail or e-mail. No telephone entries!** Please fill out entries completely and don't forget to include your telephone number (home & cell) and e-mail address. Entry fees must be paid **before** you run your dog. We will only draw those dogs for which we have completed entries at the time of the closing. If it is necessary to cancel or revise an entry you may do so by telephone or e-mail, but please do not assume that this is accomplished until you receive an acknowledgement of the change. The Comfort Inn at Barkeyville and the Super 8 are the closest to the trial grounds. Grove City, in the area surrounding the "Prime Outlets", is growing rapidly and there are a few very nice motels. The Pennsylvania Brittany Club is privately owned and only members of the club are allowed to train on the grounds. Due to insurance & liability issues, training of dogs by non-members is not permitted on the grounds of The Pennsylvania Brittany Club at any time. This includes before or after a field trial and/or hunt test.

## **PA BRITTANY CLUB GROUNDS RULES & REGULATIONS**

- There are a limited number of electrical hook-ups. Bring heavy duty electrical cord. Each camper is limited to one outlet.
- No one will be permitted to save spots.
- Horses are to be unloaded and loaded on the road, not while trailers are in the grass parking areas.
- **Take all your trash home-PLEASE.** There is no garbage pick up at the club. All refuse left in cans must be taken home by club members following an event.
- No dogs are permitted in the clubhouse.
- DO NOT stake out horses in the parking area. If the area around the perimeter of the parking/camping area become full, horses can be staked out on the breakaway field or in the field (across the fence) below the clubhouse. However, all horses & stakeouts must be removed prior to the start of each day's running.
- The use of corrals is discouraged. If you must put up a corral, for the safety of your horses, please ask a committee member and put it in the designated area.
- Clean up all debris and dog waste in your camping area.
- Clean up hay and manure from around trailers before leaving. Break up piles of hay and scatter manure and throw into the woods.
