ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED:

- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries
- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with Int'l Money Orders guaranteed in US Funds

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED without fees or signatures

Entries not on OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (or photocopies of same which do not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by fax, telegram or e-mail **JDC_ShowSecretary@msn.com** prior to close of entries. Those received verbally by telephone are not acceptable.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

There is no space provided for unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in this show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed.

All awards will be made in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATIONS TO ASSURE THEIR DOGS ARE FREE OF INTERNAL & EXTERNAL PARASITES, ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES, AND HAVE APPROPRIATE VACCINATIONS.

NOTE: 1st Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch; Field Trial Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:

NOTE: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner’s records have completed the requirements for a *Championship* after Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the *Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition*, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at this show. (Chapter 11, Section 6, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*)

AWARD(S) OF MERIT:

The Judge may consider all Brittany’s participating in the Best of Breed competition for an Award of Merit Placement (*except for those awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed and Best of Winners*). The number of Awards of Merit presented shall be at the discretion of the Judge.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS Entry Fee: \$17.00
for stud dogs and at least two, but not more than four, of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show.

BROOD BITCH CLASS Entry Fee: \$17.00
same as for the stud dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

NOTE: As the judges decision in Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a third first place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter the corresponding Open Class at the show, provided the win is the third first place with competition and further provided there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Entry Form. All such requests must be made one-half hour prior to the judging of any Regular Classes at the show.

Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. **Bitches in season are not eligible. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.**

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge, or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by a veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their **AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER** on each entry.

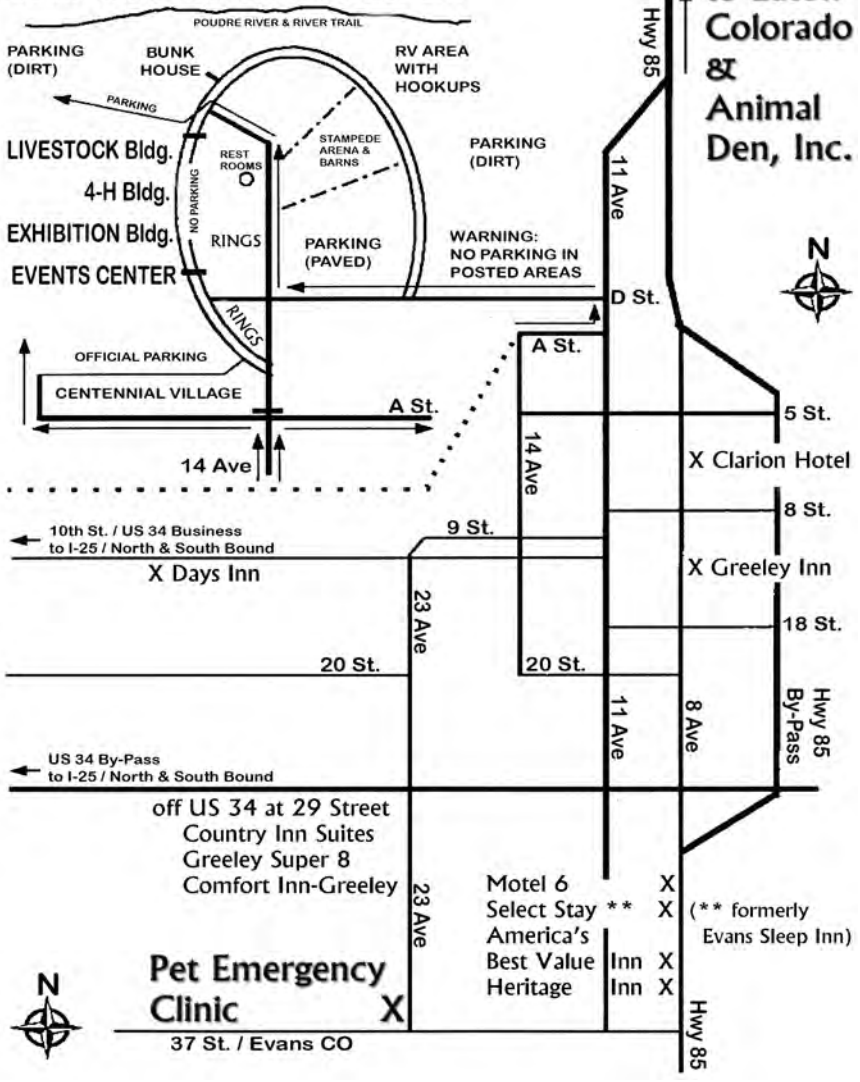

Dogs, crates & equipment must be removed from ringside immediately following Best In Show judging (within 15 minutes) on Sunday, August 16, 2009. Any equipment left in the building after BIS or BISS's will be removed and a \$25.00 service fee will be assessed for return of the equipment.

NO VEHICLES will be allowed to enter the park between 10:00 p.m. & 6:00 a.m.

NO DOGS should be out of their vehicles between 11:00 p.m. & 6:00 a.m.

NO GENERATORS to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times

Same day parking is available & marked on "D" Street west of the Unloading Areas.

RV sites that are not filled by 7 a.m. Saturday to Best In Show may be used as Day Parking. All RV's must be in their assigned reserved spaces by 8 p.m. Friday.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. - (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

This parking is a privilege extended by the GKC and this privilege can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow these rules, regulations and instructions of the Club Members, Officers and Guards on Duty. Any breach of these terms will be reported to the Show Committee. The fees are charged to help defray the costs of the Security Guards.

Overnight parking will be available beginning at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 12, 2009. Anyone wanting to camp in the park prior to this time will need to pay an additional fee to the City of Greeley – Fees are from \$10.00 to \$20.00 per day. No overnight parking in the park without a paid fee – check-in at Island Grove Regional Park Office in the Exhibition Building, 525 N. 15th Avenue, between 7:00 a.m. & 3:30 p.m.

Vehicles in the park before 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 12, 2009 and not in their assigned parking space, will be moved.

All overnight parking, with or without electric, is based on time and date of receipt of reservation request – BY MAIL ONLY – or if available at the time of your arrival at the show site, if you do not have a mail reservation. GKC assumes no responsibility for mail services and will not sign for incoming mail, accept postage due mail, and WILL NOT ACCEPT E-MAIL OR PHONE RESERVATIONS.

You will park at the direction of the GKC Parking Staff & Committee & Guards on Duty. All set-ups must be made within your assigned space. All units must be self contained. Exhibitors will be responsible for clean-up of their areas. Trash dumpsters will be provided. No discharge of gray water or sanitary tanks is permitted. RV dump site is available near the show grounds north of the Stampedo Grandstands & Arena – Thursday thru Sunday, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

NO In-Out privileges during show hours. Some areas will be barricaded & no RV traffic will be allowed in or out from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. each day. Exceptions will be made for emergencies and / or emergency equipment. If you need to leave your site due to an emergency situation, you must provide your own type of reserved site identification.

If you want to park next to a friend, mail your reservation and fees in the same envelope.

Some RV sites, without electricity, are available west of the buildings & in the east parking lot, if being closer to the buildings is more important than having electrical power.

RV RIGS MORE THAN 50 FEET IN LENGTH will need 2 sites if you are requesting to park in sites on grass. **SLIDEOUTS WILL NOT WORK AT ALL ON GRASS SITES DUE TO FIRE LANES AND TREES.** If a site is not available on grass at the time of your request, you will be put in the best spot available at the time and a refund will be made for the second site. You may have multiple rigs / vehicles within your site(s), but all rigs / vehicles must be inside your assigned marked site. **ALL SLIDEOUTS MUST BE FLAGGED OR CONED FOR SAFETY.**

Reservations for Overnight Parking must be made by the designated Closing of Entries for GKC shows – NOON, JULY 29, 2009 – after which time reservations will not be accepted and will be returned.

Requests for refunds for parking can be made UP TO NOON, AUGUST 12, 2009, after which time, requests will not be accepted and refunds will not be made.
