Directions: The field trial will be held at the Sam Page Farm, 380 Mary Hanna Road off U.S. Hwy 221, five miles south of Woodruff, SC 29688. There is easy access off I-85 and I-26. From the north I-26 intersects with Hwy 221. Continue on Hwy 221 through the small downtown area of Woodruff. Hwy 221 parallels a railroad track. About 5 miles south of Woodruff just past **Enoree Church of God** (which is on the left if driving south) take the first right which goes over the railroad tracks and is Mary Hanna Road. Road sign may be hard to see. Watch for field trial sign. If you have gone to 13851 Hwy 221 you have gone too far. Field trial grounds are located on the first house on the left (380 Mary Hanna Road) which has a stone “setter” on the front lawn.
From the south, exit I-26 at Enoree (Exit 41).

Camping/Misc: Camping is permitted. No hook-ups. Clubhouse will be available to us during the trial. It will be locked until the morning of March 13, 2010 so make plans for potable water if you arrive Friday. Water for dogs and horses plus potable water will be available on the grounds. Negative Coggins test needed for horses.

Food: Morning coffee/donuts and lunches will be available both days for a small cost. *Meet and Greet* time for a BBQ dinner will follow the day’s running on Saturday, March 13th. Please bring your favorite appetizer or dessert. Cost of dinner will be posted in the clubhouse.

Motels and Lodging: There are over 20 restaurants within 1 ½ mile radius of the two lodging places noted below. Westgate Mall (largest mall in South Carolina) is nearby. Super 8 has free continental breakfast. Denny’s restaurant is nearby in front of Super8 Motel and near the Sleep Inn which is across the road from Super8.

Super 8 Motel at 488 South Blackstock Road, Spartanburg, SC 29301, I-26 Exit 22, Reidville Road at 864-576-2488. King size room approximately \$46.71 plus 10% tax. Pets allowed for \$10 more/night. For discount mention the Southeastern Brittany Club. Two double beds \$48.41 plus 10% tax per night.

Sleep Inn 501 South Blackstock Road, Spartanburg, SC 29301 at 864-595-4040 off I-26, Exit 22, Reidville Road. Room rate is approximately \$62.00 plus tax. Pets are allowed for \$15.00/night. Mention Southeastern Brittany Club.

Please Note: On Sunday, March 14, 2010 at 2AM Daylight Saving Time begins in the USA. Spring forward and move your clock one hour ahead. This is a reminder so that someone does not miss their stake and brace time/position.
