



## DIRECTIONS TO GROUNDS

FROM THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 4, ROUTE 150  
AND COUNTY LINE ROAD (between Cutler and Percy):

Travel south on Route 4 approximately 1 mile  
Turn left on Pyatt-Cutler Road, Look for Pyramid Park Sign before turn.  
Travel approximately 5.5 miles east on Pyatt-Cutler Rd , passed the rail car area  
Turn left at the Tangen Cemetery Road sign—just opposite the Denmark Park  
sign (on the right) Pass through the yellow gate, turning left when  
you get to the “ levee road” . Parking lot is on the right. Space is limited, so please  
park diagonally using as little space as possible. Some off road parking is available  
on the road in front of the barn site and down the road west of the site if you have a lot  
of dogs to stake out.

Overnight camping fees on the grounds is \$8.00 per night (no hook-ups) Please see  
field trial secretary for permit form & payment options.
