Map/Directions

**** See map for directions to test location.** Hunt Test Grounds are 11.5 miles from the Faust turn off/Tooele Co. line on highway 73. From I15 Exit 279(Lehi) take main St/hwy73 West past Eagle Mountain, thru Cedar Fort, past Camp Floyd State Park, past 5mile rec area, just past the Tooele Co sign (just before the Faust turn off/SR36). Turn into dirt/gravel road to the left at the state park signage (just past Tooele sign). After turning into dirt road at state park information signs, make immediate right to put those signs on your left. *****Mileage reference below use these signs as starting/0 reference***** Follow the two lane gravel road 7.4 miles (at 7.2 miles you'll go over a cattle guard) and turn right and continue driving on dirt (not gravel) ranch road. At 10.2 miles turn right again passing by a large water tank @ 10.8 miles. Continue driving on dirt/ranch rd until hitting hunt test camp @ approx 11.5miles. Signs will be provided.

Courses and Birds

There will be a single course with a bird field for all tests. In the Master Hunter test, handlers must carry an **UNLOADED** break open shotgun. The Junior Hunter test will run for a minimum of fifteen (15) minutes. Chukar and/or Quail, and/or Pheasant and/or Pigeons will be released in all tests.
