Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

No handler horses will be provided.

Shotguns are not permitted on the grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO GROUNDS: LBJ National Grasslands - Decatur, Texas. From Hwy 380 in Decatur, go north on Hwy 730 for 9 miles. Turn left (west) at the cemetery sign which is CR 2560. Travel westerly for approximately 5 miles to CR 2675 which is gravel and turn right (northerly). Travel approximately 1.5 miles and turn right (east) on CR 2777.
