The **2011 December AKC Titles only** are now posted, these include:

- 1) **3** New Grand Champions.
- 2) **1** New Champions.
- 3) **6** New Performance titles—**1** Beginner Novice (BN) & **1** Rally Novice (RN), **1** Excellent Jumper Preferred (AJP), **1** Novice FAST Preferred (NFP), **1** Open FAST Preferred (OFP) & **1** Excellent FAST Preferred (XFP).
- 4) Sires of the 2011 Titled Get. *Check out the Top Sire for 2011*
- 5) Dams of the 2011 Titled Get. *Check out the Top Dam for 2011*
- 6) Tally titles overall counts from **1879** to date, broken down by the years.

The “Top Dogs” for 2011, in all categories, will be tallied when the new AKC Reports are received from the AKC Records Department (see below). The new titles reports are still being sent to the SBCA and then are forwarded to me for updating the Archives.

### The Working Dog Reports:

Titles and reports come from our Working Dog Committee and are updated as received.

### The AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB has ceased publication of the AWARDS before the 2011 calendar year ended:

As a result, we will be slow in getting the show results needed to update the Saint Bernard National Archives and Hall of Fame. Reports are now to be generated by the AKC Records Department on request (for a fee), and at this point in time I do not have a time-frame of how this will all play out.

### Since My Last Post:

In correspondence with the AKC Records Department we were first led to believe there would be a charge of \$420.00 a year (\$35 a month) to pull the statistics we need on a *monthly basis*. Now we are told there is a \$420.00 charge for monthly reports for BOTH conformation and performance—that is \$840.00 a year (\$70 a month) to update *the Archives on a monthly basis*. Another option is to update four times a year instead of twelve times a year for a lesser fee.

### For The Moment:

The Saint Bernard Club of Puget Sound (SBCPS) and the Working Dog Committee (WDC) have stepped forward to donate **\$840.00** for monthly reports which will keep the Saint Bernard National Archives and Hall of Fame functioning for another year as we are all accustomed. Needless to say this is a HUGE amount of \$\$\$ for a local club and committee to donate. The SBCPS was willing to support the Archives/Hall of Fame on a yearly basis, but when the price was doubled for Performance and Conformation the cost become unrealistic for one club. This is when the WDC offered a one-time donation so there is no interruption to the data collecting in all of our fields of competition. We all owe a great deal of gratitude to the SBCPS & WDC for this funding. This gift gives to all of you the continuing use of the Archives for one more year. I hope you will take a mere moment and send a Thank You note to the SBCPS and WDC, or if you are so inclined, a donation to help defray costs for the moment.
