Something to consider when naming your puppy and registering that name with the AKC:

When naming your new puppy and registering that name with the AKC, you might want to consider not making the name *too* long. A long name (including spaces between *many* words) tends to get cut off in the database fields. As a result, your puppy will not receive the recognition it deserves when it starts to earn titles as its name will appear “chopped off.” We surely don’t want that to happen! ☹️ **A point to ponder!**
