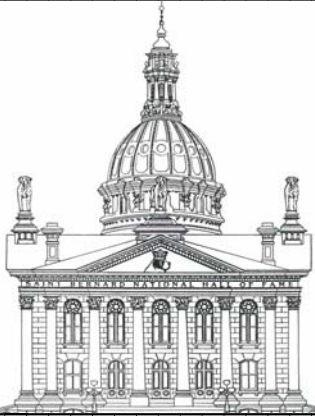


Hall of Fame Record - Independent Specialty High In Trials

Twin Oaks Honey Bear was sired by Ch. Serendipity's Mister Opdyke & Ch. Twin Oaks Cinnamon Bear, UDT. Cindy was out of our first litter and Honey was out of our first homebred litter. Cindy held the record as the only AKC CH-UDT for many years. Honey was whelped 2/17/73. One of her litter mates was Twin Oaks Hershey Bear. He earned a CDX title.

Honey was about 2 years old when she started training for obedience. Prior to that time she was mostly shown in conformation. Her show career was ended because she had to be spayed. Her first Novice B competition was at the Ohio Specialty. She had her first High In Trial at that show. From there she went on to become very competitive in the obedience ring.

She was a very intelligent Saint. You could almost see her thinking. She was one step ahead of me most of the time and what a great ambassador for our the breed. She loved everyone and also loved to get attention. There was always a crowd around the ring when she was showing. Honey was very adaptable. If I couldn't make it to the ring, Donna would take her in and do as well as I could. Donna earned one of Honey's High In Trails at the Wisconsin National Specialty in 1977.

Tracking with Honey was quite an experience. The day she earned her TD title there was an ax on her track and she stopped, picked it up and brought it to me. She then continued with her track and found the glove.

Honey earned 22 points toward her OTCH. She was in competition when the OTCH began so all of the top dogs were earning their points at the same time and it was quite difficult to earn points. I had become a tracking, obedience and breed judge so could not spend as much time showing Honey as I would have liked to.

Her career ended in 1981. She was shown for 6 years and was the top obedience Saint in the country for most of these years. Honey had the honor of going High In Trial at 4 National Specialties and 7 other Specialties. She was also High In Trial at 1 All Breed Obedience Trial.

Honey was very special to our family and will always have a very special place in our hearts.
