AKC offers the CGC as a "title" in 2013. These new "titles" are recorded from the AKC reports. Prior CGC "certificates" are not reflected in the reports.

One can now pass the CGC test but a "title" is awarded ONLY if an additional fee is paid to AKC. If the owner does not purchase the "title" it is not recorded in our databases.

The CGC test will be held to a higher standard by requiring the signature of an observer on the evaluation form and by requiring both new evaluators and experienced evaluators at the time they re-apply to view a video of a passing CGC performance and attest that they will strive to achieve this quality of testing. Dogs must be registered or listed with the AKC to receive the title. Owners whose dogs have passed the CGC test since January 1, 2001 may apply to have the title added to their dog's record. A nominal processing fee will apply.
