

Pre-entries close at Trial Secretary's Office at 6:00 PM, September 26, 2008. Gate entries for Intro To Quarry will be accepted until 9:00 AM on the day of the Test. Pre-entries can not be accepted, canceled or substituted after the closing date except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Directions to Trial Site

From the New Jersey Turnpike, Exit 7, proceed north towards Bordentown 1.4 miles to third traffic light. At light, turn right on Route 528 (Crosswicks Street, bank on corner) towards Chesterfield. Immediately after crossing over the turnpike (1.2 miles), turn left on Route 672 towards Crosswicks. Site is on the right approximately 0.3 miles.

Ribbons: A rosette will be awarded to all Junior, Senior and Master entries earning a qualifying score. A ribbon will be awarded to all Intro To Quarry entries earning a qualifying score.

Trophies: Each entry earning a qualifying score in the Junior, Senior or Master Class will be awarded a dog toy and a selection of dog goodies.

Additional Trophies: Additional trophies specific to the breed of the entry have been made available by parent Breed Clubs and Earthdog enthusiasts. A list of those trophies can be downloaded from the STCA website after August 31, 2008 or mailed upon written request to the Test Secretary.

Eligible Breeds: Dachshunds and Terrier Breeds - Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Smooth Fox, Wire Fox, Glen of Imaal, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh and West Highland White.

Move Ups: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the written request of the owner, as the result of qualifying for an Earthdog title. Such requests must be received by the Test Secretary no later than the 8:00 AM on the day of the Test. Such move ups will be accepted regardless of the class entry. Dogs moving up will be added at the end of the running order for that class.

Notice To All Exhibitors

- Dogs must be at least 6 months of age, register with the AKC or an AKC recognized foreign registry or have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) number. Neutered or spayed entries are allowed.
- Bitches in season may not be entered. Refunds will not be given to bitches in season unless withdrawn before entries close.
- Pre-entries will be acknowledged by e-mail.
- Orientation will begin at the stated start time for each class
- Master Earthdog braces will be drawn 15 minutes before the class start time. All entries must be checked in no later than 30 minutes before the class start time. Dogs not present within 5 minutes after its brace is called will be marked absent by the judge.
- Fees must accompany entries. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fees. No phone entries will be accepted. Entries must be accompanied by the Release Form signed by the handler or legal guardian if the handler is a minor.
- Water and beverages will be available at the test site.
- Dogs not running a test must be on leash or confined at all times. Owners are responsible for the safety of their dog(s) and for any actions of their dog(s). Excessive correction or abusive treatment is grounds for disciplinary action.

- Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's office without recipient's signature.
- Master Earthdog is open only to dogs that have earned the Senior or Master Earthdog title before entries close.
- Senior Earthdog is open only to dogs that have earned the Junior or Master Earthdog title before entries close.
- Junior Earthdog is open to all eligible dogs that have not recorded or received a qualifying leg in a Senior Test, and those dogs that have earned a Master Earthdog title.

Lunch

Lunch will be available at the test site. See the coupon on the next page to order lunch in advance. Please note that there is a discount for paying for the lunch with your entry. Coffee, donuts and soda will be provided by the STCA at a nominal charge. The torpedo is 10" long and considered a single serving. The ½ Hoagie is substantially larger and considered 2 servings. All profits from this lunch will support the STCA Rescue Trust.

Further Notice to Participants

All persons entering the Test Grounds must sign a waiver of liability before being permitted on the grounds. This requirement applies to exhibitors, spectators and minors. Parents or guardians must sign for any minors accompanying them. While there have never been any problems on these test grounds in the past and every precaution will be taken to minimize any possible hazard, these are open fields with the potential for rough terrain, presence of wildlife and similar risks as well as all those risks associated with dog events.
